Catholic United Raffle

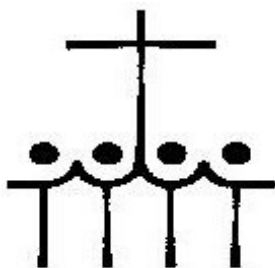
