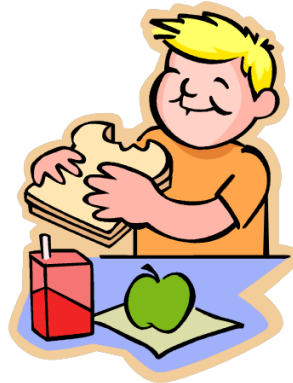

Flu Shots

The SFCS Volunteer Nurses Program is once again sponsoring a student flu shot clinic in conjunction with fall conferences, Thurs., October 29th. The clinic will be open from 9 a.m. to 7p.m. in the O'Gorman High School Cafeteria for children between the ages of 6 months to 18 years at a cost of \$1 per child. There will be 200 doses of Intranasal (mist form) vaccine available. Children must either be accompanied by a parent or have a parent-signed consent form to participate. Please note there is a different consent form for each vaccine delivery method (shot or mist). Forms are available in the school office. No adult vaccines will be available at this clinic.

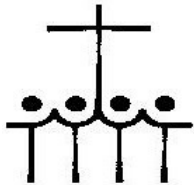
