## PE News

All students in grades K-6 must wear tennis shoes to gym class. These shoes must have **NON-MARKING SOLES**. Most manufacturers state this on the box or shoe. Please check this before purchasing shoes for gym class.

Students in grades K-3 should dress comfortably on the days they have gym. If girls wear skirts on gym days, they must have shorts on underneath. Please keep all long hair pulled back as this is a safety concern.

Students in grades 4-6 are required to have a gym uniform. This uniform consists of blue shorts and a gray T-shirt. The uniform is available at the Knight Locker at O'Gorman High School. P.E. uniforms must be marked with the student's name on both articles. Students who forget their P. E. uniform will still participate, but it will affect their P.E. grade.

If for some reason a student must be excused from a gym class, please write a note to me stating the reason why the
