

## SFCS ELEMENTARY UNIFORM CODE

Pants	Shirts
Navy blue color	White shirts of any style and sleeve length with a collar or turtleneck
Twill or corduroy material only	
Worn at the natural waistline	All shirts must be tucked in at all times
No royal blue color, decorations, prints, denim	No decorations, logos, contrasting colors, T-shirts, undershirts or tank tops
No jogging, cargo, carpenter or capri styles	
Only girls Preschool-Grade 3 may wear leggings or stretch pants (and only with a skirt or jumper)	Preferred shirts: long/short sleeved polos, cotton with collar, turtlenecks or mock turtlenecks
May be purchased from local vendors or the Dennis Uniform Company	May be purchased from local vendors or the Dennis Uniform Company
	Polo shirts with school logo may be purchased through the SFO at certain times of the school year

Shorts	Sweaters/Sweatshirts
Navy blue walking shorts (just above knees)	Sweatshirts with school logo may be purchased through the SFO at certain times of the school year
Style must be the same as uniform pant and worn at natural waistline	
May only be worn in August, September, October, April & May	Navy blue sweaters may be purchased from local vendors or the Dennis Uniform Company
May be purchased from local vendors or the Dennis Uniform Company	Navy blue fleece vests--purchased only from the Dennis Uniform Company--are optional
	Collared shirts must be worn under sweatshirts, sweaters and fleece vests

Skirts & Jumpers	P.E. Uniforms
Plaid skirt/jumper and plaid/navy blue skort--purchased only from the Dennis Uniform Company--are optional	Required for Grades 4-6 only
Skirts, jumpers and skorts must be just above the knee	SFCS gray T-shirts and blue shorts--must be purchased from Knight Locker at OGHS

Other	General
Socks must be worn with all types of shoes/sandals (must have back straps). The acceptable colors for socks are black, white or navy only.	Some clothing fringes on violating the intent of the uniform code. Since we are unable to list all exceptions to the uniform, we ask for student and parent cooperation by wearing clothing styles congruent with the intended code.
Shoes should be neutral colored; for safety reasons <i>Crocs</i> are not allowed, <i>Ugg</i> style boots and clogs are not to be worn inside	
Jewelry should not be excessive	Dress up/down attire must be appropriate (Administrative discretion)--see Student/Parent Handbook for details
Boys may not wear earrings	Dress up/down attire is not allowed on Mass days
Boys' hair must be above the collar; rat tails and mohawks are not allowed	
Inappropriate or unnatural hair color is not allowed (Administrative discretion)	
Make-up is not allowed	

\*Attire for cold days shall be appropriate. When there is snow on the ground, boots and snowpants are mandatory.
